I first learned about CAMP University through my good friend, Emily Sasser, and her parents, Ford and Abbie. I was unaware of the challenges families face when their young children with learning differences graduate from high school. I learned the options were few and often quite grim outside of the home, with many young, vibrant individuals relegated to adult daycare facilities while their parents were at work.

I firmly believe God chooses individuals to carry out His mission, and often the chosen are wholly unaware of His plan for many years. When a parent learns that their child is diagnosed with an intellectual, physical or developmental difference, most families enter survival mode: their vision narrows to the immediate future. "Does our child require medical treatment in-utero?" "How will we handle the extra responsibility—and cost—of ongoing medical needs, etc.?" "Am I even strong enough to walk this road?" "How, and why, did this happen?" The questions and concerns mount to an overwhelming degree. But how beautiful it is to serve a creator whose vision exceeds ours.

When Emily graduated high school, the Sassers confronted a scenario facing every family who shares their experience. Were it not for their personal need, C.A.M.P. University may never have sprouted, and our CAMPers would not have this haven to develop and grow alongside their friends. God knew who he chose, and he chose wisely.

On March 5, 2022, my family welcomed to this world our greatest blessing imaginable: Jamison Patrick Moore. Learning that my wife, Courtney, was pregnant, we were excited and poised. After all, this was our third child; we were seasoned pros. Thirteen weeks into the pregnancy, we received news that changed our lives forever: there was a 98% chance Jamison had Down syndrome. (It turns out he 100% has Down syndrome, by the way.) Poise turned to fear and uncertainty.

Thankfully, God placed a tremendous community around us. Fear and uncertainty turned to resilience and preparation. Our son is our son, and our son is so much more than a diagnosis. The people God chose to walk this path before us loved and guided us along the way. They were an absolute blessing. And when we finally met Jamison in the flesh, we knew our lives changed for the better; our daughters' lives changed for the better; the world changed for the better.

Jamison is three years old, happy, stubborn, and an unbridled blast to be around. He turns the worst day into the best—every single time. Every family CAMP serves has their Jamison. Each CAMPer has unique needs, but one need is certain: they need, and deserve, people that value, cherish and challenge them. CAMP University is that home-away-from-home, and a community of support for CAMPers and their families.

It is an honor and a privilege to serve on CAMP's Board of Directors. I have learned so much about the work and sacrifice it takes to keep this organization running, and I count it pure joy to play a small role in its success. The staff works tirelessly to ensure each CAMPer and their families have the best experience possible. I encourage anyone and everyone to support CAMP in any way feasible. Their mission is unmatched, and our CAMPers are worth it.

David's all about Sonic, tickling the ivories, and chatting up a storm about anything Wii game-related!



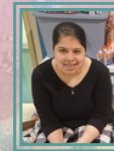
Matthew V. kicks off every meeting with his iconic handshake flair. He's also a puzzle-solving maestro with his pals.

Kisai is all about jamming to Selena Quintanilla, busting out dance moves, and chitchatting with her pals!

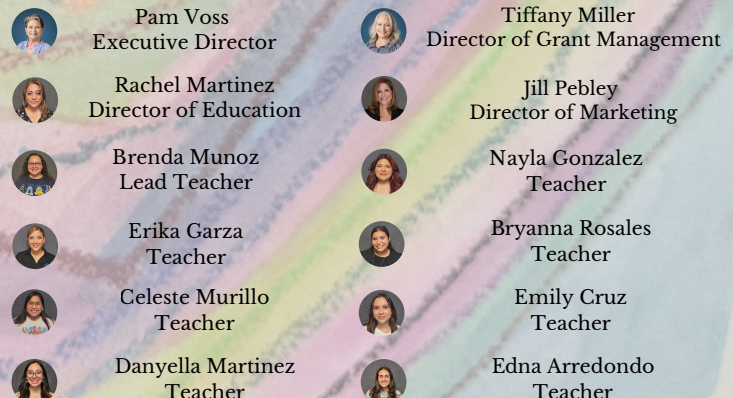


Stephanie T. is a chatterbox when it comes to fashion and retail therapy with her pals. She's also a craft queen, snipping and gluing her way to creative bliss!

Lemonade Stand

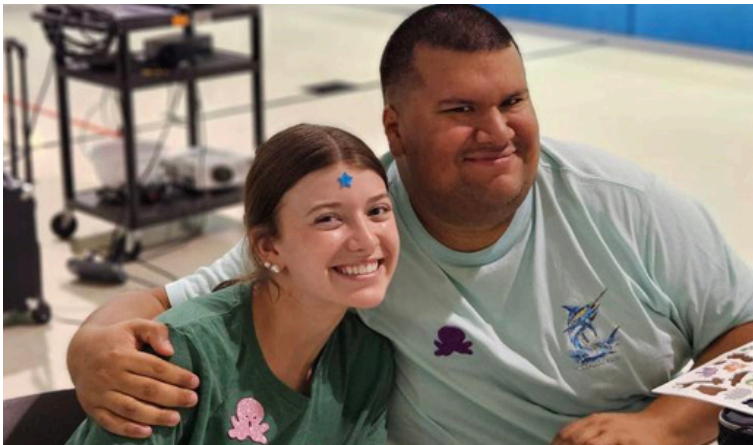
Our 2nd annual Lemonade Stand was a success

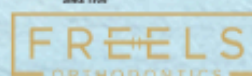
