NEW PROCEDURES

May 1, 2020

In order to minimize the number of people at CAMP as per state recommendations, parents will not be allowed inside the building neither for drop off nor pick up. We will have a carline marked for efficiency. A staff member will be outside to take the CAMPers temperature before they get out of their car. If a fever is present or if the CAMPer is exhibiting any of the symptoms listed at the bottom of this letter, that CAMPer will not be allowed in the building and may not attend for 14 days or until we receive a negative test result. If temperature is normal, the CAMPer will be allowed to enter the building and a staff member will clock them in, minimizing computer contamination. The CAMPer will be given a pump of hand sanitizer as they enter.

Please make sure your CAMPer arrives on time so that the transition back will be smooth and all precautions can be taken. We will be locking ALL doors at 9:30 am. Any CAMPer arriving after that time will have to call the CAMP office (956-800-5292) so someone can come take their temperature, etc.

We ask that **no personal items** be brought to CAMP other than lunch. If we see a CAMPer with bags, (this includes backpacks and purses) they will be asked to leave them in the car. We are trying to minimize the possibility of carrying in more germs. For our female CAMPers please bring a supply of personal items that may be needed to leave at CAMP. We will provide a storage space in the girl's bathroom.

Lessons will be held in the gym where we can maintain proper distancing. There will only be 2 CAMPers at each table (one on each side). At this time CAMPers will be given a personal set of activity supplies that only they will use that must remain at CAMP.

We will insist on and monitor handwashing throughout the day.

We will not be allowing CAMPers into the kitchen. Please minimize the amount of microwave lunches as staff will be heating up the lunches for the CAMPers. Please also note that lunch boxes will be kept at the CAMPer's seat and will not be put in the refrigerator. Please pack accordingly. If a parent needs to drop off lunch, please call the office and we will either meet you at the door or curbside to get the lunch for the CAMPer.

Our water fountain will be off to minimize contact. Your CAMPer is required to bring a water bottle. We have filter water we can refill their water bottles with if/when needed.

We are doing our absolute best to make sure that everything is disinfected daily. In addition to cleaners, we will also be exposing all surfaces to UVC light. We have installed hand sanitizer stations at both entrances, outside the bathrooms and at the kitchen door.

Things to remember:

- NO bags or purses
- Long hair must be tied back
- Face masks are optional but highly recommended.
- Gloves are optional but recommended
- A full water bottle is required
- CAMP will not provide facemasks for CAMPers

- If a CAMPer refuses to wash their hands, they will be sent home immediately

Please screen your CAMPer before bringing them to CAMP for any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19
